All clients will be allowed a **Maximum of 25-pounds** of gear per person on your trip including all bags and personal items.

How can you pack under 25-Pounds?

- We supply the heavy items! Both Rain Gear and Rubber Boots.
- Listen to our gear List (We've been at this a long time and 90% of our guest only use 50% of what they bring!)
- We can do Laundry on a limited basis as needed.
- All Towels and Bedding included.
- No Hard Suitcases. (We have safe storage for extra travel clothes on shore and can provide you with a duffel if you've flown; or please bring your own to transfer your things once you arrive)

## Footwear and Raingear

We provide clean waterproof footwear and rain gear. (Only bring your own, if it fits withing your **25-pound** gear limit) If you have an abnormal foot size please let us know in advance.

- Hot weather footwear (flipflops, sandals ect.)
- Everyday shoes for boat, and travel

## Clothing

- 1 medium layer
- 1 warm layer
- Long pants
- Shorts
- Shirts
- Swimsuit
- Socks/Personals
- Hat
- Buff (If you use them)

## Miscellaneous

- Personals: Cosmetics/Toothbrush/Medications
- Camera if not your Phone.
- Charging Cords/Cubes. We have regular 110 power for charging
- Sunglasses/reading glasses
- Sunscreen
- Sat Phone or Sat Texting Unit (optional) **We have these on board for emergencies.**
- Fishing License: Purchase Annual or 5 day starting day 1 of your trip and with Salmon Stamp added. <https://recfish-pechesportive.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/nrls-sndpp/index-eng.cfm>

## Spirits/Drinks

Please purchase your Spirits the day before when you arrive in Kitimat as we depart early day 1 before any stores are open. This will not count in your 25-pound limit but please we need you to be respectful and thoughtful here as to weight limits. We do have weight constraints on our crew boat for large groups so please follow these guidelines. Remember we have to take all glass back to shore along with a great deal of frozen fish!!

- No Glass beer bottles
- Beer in the can only
- Hard Alcohol should be purchased in Plastic bottles if at all possible.
- Boxed Wine Gets a big thumbs up from us. (I think a lot of us are Wine snobs, ourselves included but let's try to keep it to the box for a few days.)
- Please do not bring any mix, water, or soda. (Let us know well in advance if you need something special and it will be provided. We have all the basics on board)
- Plastic, Aluminum and Boxes over Glass! Thankyou!

## Coolers

If you are driving, we will leave your coolers in your vehicle. Please do not pack a cooler to bring to the mothership we have plenty. If you fly to Terrace we will have Cooler Boxes for purchase at the end of your trip for transporting your fish home.

## Fishing Gear

We provide all high-quality rods, reels, lures and gear. We ask that you don't bring your own. Your favorite lure or mooching rod you can't live without is fine but keep in mind it will be included in your 25-pound personal weight limit. Our gear is very high-quality, feel free to chat with us about it if you have questions.

## Food / Dietary Concerns

- Please do not bring food (we take a lot of pride in feeding you the right way, we have tonnes of food and snacks. If you have any special requests just let us know in advance and we will have it on board.
- Please Let us know if you have any **allergies, dietary restrictions, or special diets**. We are flexible and can accommodate you if you let us know well in advance. We know there are many ways of eating these days just let us know.
